

Barn Owl Nursery - Lavender Selection Guide - *Lavandula angustifolia* cultivars

Most of these lavenders have dark purple-blue to medium blue-violet flowers in June.

Many are used fresh and dried for a variety of crafts and culinary uses.

They have attractive silver, wooly foliage & dark violet flowers on long silver stems.

****Lavandula x gingsii* 'Goodwin Creek Grey'**

Height Stem Length Flowers:

20-36" 8-12" long stems and spikes with bright blue-violet flowers

In the Pacific NW, the flowers start blooming in early spring and will bloom continuously throughout summer and early fall, if pruned regularly. This unique *Lavandula* grows fast and has striking, wooly silver foliage with multiple lobed silver leaves. It is considered a tender lavender and grows best in mild, frost-free climates. It can be grown in a large container as a specimen plant. In mild climates, it can be grown outdoors in the garden as a focal point or in a border

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Barn Owl Nursery - Lavandin Selection Guide - *Lavandula x intermedia* cultivars

Lavandin cultivars are a hybrid cross between *L. angustifolia* and *L. latifolia*.

Usually, these cultivars start blooming in July in Western Oregon. They are large plants with silver winter foliage. They have long flower spikes on long stems. Most of these cultivars have light violet-blue buds and flowers, except where noted. Some are known to produce a high yield of very fragrant essential oil and are noted as an **oil** plant. All can be used for fresh and dried bouquets and buds and for making crafts. Some of these cultivars are planted to form hedges and borders and to line driveways, and grown for their beauty and fragrance.
